DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Ladies and Gentlemen,

As Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Ballarat Base and Associated Hospitals Credit Co-operative Limited it is my privilege and pleasure to present, on behalf of the Board of Directors, the Eleventh Annual Report for the year ended 31st March, 1980.

The past year has been yet another year of significant growth in all areas of the Credit Co-operative, indicating the confidence of our members.

Finances:

The Finance Statement shows a surplus of \$8,059 after providing \$1,658 for income tax, and \$4,000 for doubtful accounts. The Cooperative remains in a sound financial position with General and Statutory Reserves now totalling \$36,232.

Investments have increased considerably and now total \$311,920.

Membership:

Membership has continued to grow to an all high time of 404, with 96 new members being allotted shares during the year, and 60 members withdrawing their shares following resignation from one of the hospitals associated with the Co-operative.

Loans:

During the year 188 loans were approved totalling \$407,151. The Co-operative has assisted members to purchase motor vehicles, make home improvements, purchase property, finance holidays, consolidate existing debts and for many other miscellaneous purposes. Statistical details of the number and amount of loans are found later in this report.

Interest on loans has continued to be calculated at the rate of 1% per month on the outstanding balance at the beginning of each month.

Savings:

Both members and non-member savers have taken advantage of the excellent interest rates being offered with \$739,033 on deposit at the close of the books on 31st March, 1980. Deposits during the year totalled \$1,189,991, and withdrawals \$1,015,383.

Board of Directors:

The Board of Directors met regularly on the second Thursday of each month, with special Finance Meetings arranged to consider any urgent loans for members.

Membership of the Board remained unchanged during the year.

On behalf of the members I wish to thank my fellow Directors for their attendance at meetings, and the interest and support given to ensure prompt and fair attention to all requests.

General:

The Credit Co-operative became a referral agent for A.N.Z. Travellers Cheques as an additional service for members. Several members now have also taken advantage of the competitive rates being offered by V.A.C.C. Insurance on referral from the Co-operative.

Owing to the rapid growth and utilization of the Co-operative by the members, the Board approved the appointment of a clerk to ensure that an efficient service may continue to be provided. The appointment will take effect from 1st April, 1980 and consequently an increase in the interest rate on loans by .1% to 1.1% was necessary and will take effect from 1st May, 1980.

Office furniture and supplies have been purchased to allow the commencement of this new improved service to the members.

Appreciation:

The Directors extend their appreciation to the Base Hospital Board of Management for their assistance and support of the Credit Cooperative, as without its approval we could not function.

I record my personal thanks to the Board of Directors, the Officers and staff, who together ensure the smooth and efficient running of the Co-operative.

We look forward to the next year with confidence and hope that there will be continued growth.
