### RESIDENT SURGEON'S REPORT.

---

During the year 1868, 1090 persons have been treated in the Hospital, of whom 320, nearly one-third of the whole, were suffering from injuries, and 770 admitted on the recommendations of subscribers. Of the total number of patients treated, 112 died; 891 were discharged cured, relieved, or at their own request, and 87 remained under treatment on December 31st. It is much regretted that many persons suffering from chronic diseases, and having a Subscriber's recommendation, have of necessity been refused admission, owing to the present limited accommodation.

THE TWELFTH ANNUAL REPORT  
OF THE  
COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT  
OF THE  
BALLARAT DISTRICT HOSPITAL.

---

THE Committee of the Ballarat District Hospital are happy to be in a position to come before the Governors and Subscribers at the close of their year of office, with statistics which prove that although the claims on the charity have been heavy during the period mentioned, the income has been equal to requirements.

Although the supporters of the Ballarat District Hospital have good reasons for being proud of the institution as a home for the sick and wounded, and although every year which is added to its history takes nothing from its lustre, yet the Committee feel it to be their duty, most particularly at this time, to urge upon them the necessity of unanimity and liberality during the year 1869, in order that the building may be enlarged to meet the growing necessities of this increasing and important district.

Before placing in your hands the Resident Surgeon's Report, and the usual financial statements for the year that is past, the Committee wish to record their thanks to the Government of Victoria, the Borough Councils of Ballarat and district, the clergy of the several religious denominations, the officers and members of the various friendly societies of Ballarat, and the numerous other subscribers who have so cordially supported them during their term of office, and trust their successors may experience the same hearty co-operation from the same sources during the ensuing year.

Under this head the Committee consider that special thanks are due to the Hon. Thomas Learmonth, who, on the occasion of his departure to his native land on a visit, gave the munificent sum of one thousand pounds as a voluntary donation to the funds of the Hospital. Such conduct is beyond all praise, and is one among many instances of generosity so habitual to the hon. gentleman in question. At the request of the donor, the sum was invested in corporation securities, and forms the nucleus of an endowment fund, which, it may be hoped, may be added to at frequent intervals by those whom Providence has blessed with the means to gratify their charitable dispositions.

The year 1868 will be long remembered by the Committee for another reason, viz., that through the spontaneous and energetic exertions of the Friendly Societies of Ballarat, a grand demonstration fete was successfully got up and held at the Botanical Gardens, on Boxing day, for the benefit of the building fund of the Alfred Memorial Wing to be erected, and the result of their cheerfully accorded support and zeal was so large in the aggregate, while so trifling in the individual pecuniary outlay, that it must be gratifying to all who may hereafter take part in similar demonstrations to know that although the price of each ticket to the gardens on the day referred to, was only one shilling, the Friendly Societies were enabled to clear a sum of over £650 after paying the heavy expenses incidental to the entertainments provided. The Hospital Committee gratefully record their appreciation of such disinterested, zealous, and united action for the benefit of the charity they have the honour to represent.

Ballarat being so great a mining centre it is not surprising that the annual number of mining accidents should form a large percentage of the cases admitted into the Hospital. This fact has never been lost sight of by the Committee, and the most sudden or distressing accident that can befall a miner at his work will, without notice or ceremony, be (as heretofore) promptly and, we trust, successfully attended to.

The miners of Ballarat and district have always subscribed freely to the Hospital Funds,—no less a sum than £891

11s. 7d. having been contributed by companies and accident funds in connection therewith during 1868; for which support the Committee are grateful, and feel that should circumstances require them to make a special appeal at any time to the miners of this district, such appeal would be unhesitatingly responded to. 1090 applicants have been admitted into the wards during the past year, and 4473 have attended as out-door patients 17,998 times.

At the commencement of the year the Trustees, anticipating danger to the Hospital buildings from the operations of gold mining companies in the immediate vicinity, made application to Government to perfect their title by issue of Crown Grant, it was then discovered that only one of the present Trustees had been duly gazetted, this oversight of former years was remedied by calling a meeting of the Governors and Subscribers to the charity when the Trustees were formally re-elected and the Crown grant handed over to them.

The urgent necessity for a further extension of the Hospital, decided the Committee in calling for prize designs for the requisite accommodation, six were received and one accepted, conditionally upon the Architect's estimate of cost not exceeding the limit named, viz., £3500 for the portion at present required.

An alteration has been deemed necessary regarding the attendance of the out-door patients, owing to the great number applying for advice and treatment, and the impossibility of the resident Surgeon devoting sufficient time to a careful diagnosis of cases presented; three days in each week, viz., Monday, Wednesday, and Friday have therefore been set apart for such purpose in place of Tuesday and Friday as formerly.

The domestic economy of the Institution continues to be efficiently supervised, and various improvements from time to time judiciously effected. New steam service pipes have been placed in the laundry and drying rooms, also a qualified gardener engaged, and the grounds in the reserve placed and

maintained in excellent order. It is needless to enter into details of the minor improvements that have been carried out—the cleanliness, order, and system that prevails, must, we feel assured, speak for themselves.

The Committee acknowledges with thanks the liberality of those kind persons who from time to time have forwarded books, newspapers, and periodicals for the use of the inmates, and in conclusion testify their appreciation of the good services and untiring zeal displayed by the honorary medical and surgical staff, the resident Surgeon, with the other officers of the institution, and the members of the House Committee, who all work harmoniously together in the one noble and philanthropic cause of alleviating human distress.

R U L E S  
OF  
THE BALLARAT DISTRICT HOSPITAL.

1. The object of the Institution is to afford medical and surgical aid to poor persons requiring it, irrespective of country, colour, or creed, and for casualties ; but no persons who shall meet with casualties, and be found able to pay for aid elsewhere, shall receive further than temporary assistance.

2. In the event of any person in a position to pay for medical or surgical advice elsewhere, being detected in the receipt of the charity of the Institution, such person shall be charged at the rate of £2 per week for each week from the date of admission, if an in-patient ; or shall pay the Hospital the sum of 10s. for each occasion upon which advice may have been received at the Hospital if an out-patient, but the Committee may order the removal of any such person from the Hospital, provided the case is not one of emergency.

3. The Institution shall be governed by a President, two Vice-Presidents, five Trustees, an Honorary Treasurer, three Honorary Medical and three Honorary Surgical Officers, and sixteen Members of Committee, who with the exception of the Trustees, shall be elected annually from the Governors.

4. Every benefactor of £50 or upwards, *shall* be a Life Governor, and every contributor of £20 an Annual Governor, with *power* of having two in-patients or six out-patients always on the books of the Institution, subject to the approval of the Committee of Management hereinafter mentioned, and provided that the funds of the Institution admit of the reception of such patients ; and any public institution, corporate body or company contributing £50 in one year, shall be entitled to the privilege of a Life Governor.

5. The executor, or if more than one, the first named executor under any will, by which a bequest of £50 or upwards shall be made to the Institution, *or any* minister raising by one or more

collections in his Church, in any one year, the sum of £20 or upwards ; or any other person contributing a similar amount from any other source, shall have the rights and privileges of a Governor for one year only, commencing from the time of payment.

6. Every benefactor or *authorised* representative of a Mining Company contributing £25 or upwards in one sum, shall be a Life Subscriber, with the *privilege* of having two in-patients and six out-patients admitted annually, and contributors of smaller sums shall be entitled to recommend patients according to following scale:—

and so on, in proportion to amount of donation. Recommendations for admission to be subject to the approval of the House Committee, and to be made by tickets only, to be issued by the Secretary or Collector to the Subscribers, at the time of their becoming such, and provided that whenever any recommendation cannot be acceded to from want of room or other cause, the ticket used shall be reclaimable by the Subscriber issuing the same. Subscribers shall also have the privilege at any time on application to the Collector, of exchanging out-patients' tickets for in-patients', and *vice versa* ; one in-patient's ticket being equivalent to two out-patients'. These tickets shall only be used for the recommendation of persons unable to pay for medical attendance ; and they shall only be available for twelve months succeeding the payment.

7. Members of Committee and Honorary Medical Officers shall have a discretionary power of recommending both in-patients and out-patients, subject to the approval of the Committee.

8. Annual subscriptions must be paid in advance for the current year, such year to be computed from the day on which such subscription is paid, and no Governor or Subscriber will be entitled to any privilege until the subscription be paid.

9. No person shall vote as a Governor or Subscriber while he is a salaried officer or pupil of the Hospital, nor any new Governor or Subscriber unless his subscription shall have been paid six months previously.

10. It shall be competent at any time for the Committee of Management, at which at least eight members shall be present, or for nine or more Governors or Subscribers by a writing under their hands, to require the President to summon at the expiration of seven days, a special meeting of Governors and Subscribers, the occasion of calling such meeting being stated in the requis-

ition, and no business shall be transacted at such special meeting except that for which it shall have been summoned; every such meeting to be called by the President by advertisement in one or more of the newspapers published in Ballarat, at least four days before the day of meeting.

11. In the event of any vacancy in the offices of President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Honorary Medical Staff, or Members of Committee, the election of a successor or successors shall take place at a meeting of the Committee; but the election of Trustees shall take place at a general meeting of the Governors and Subscribers, to be convened by the Committee of Management, which election shall be according to the Act.

12. Accidents and such cases as may be deemed of decided emergency by the Honorary Medical or Surgical Officers or the Resident Surgeon, shall be received at any time, but the admission of patients in ordinary cases on the recommendation of a Governor or Subscriber, shall be restricted to Mondays and Thursdays between the hours 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. No pregnant female for the purpose of confinement, no child under five years of age, no insane person, no person afflicted with syphilis, or any infectious disease, or suffering from chronic paralysis, or any person who in the opinion of one of the Medical or Surgical Officers and Resident Surgeon, or House Committee, is unsuitable to be admitted, shall be received as an in-patient under any circumstances; and the cause of refusal of any patient so refused admittance shall be stated to the next meeting of the House Committee, by the Resident Surgeon.

13. No patient shall be discharged without a reference to the Honorary Medical Officer in charge of the case, with the exception of patients guilty of gross misconduct who may be summarily dismissed by the Resident Surgeon, such dismissal to be reported to the House Committee at its next meeting.

14. Previous to the departure of patients who may leave the Hospital at their own desire, they shall sign a declaration to that effect.

15. All recommendations must be in accordance with the printed forms supplied by the institution.

16. The Committee of Management shall direct the general business of the institution, shall frame bye-laws for its internal regulation, the same not being contrary to the general rules, and appoint and discharge all paid officers of the institution. They

shall meet on the second Wednesday in every month, and on such other days as they may appoint. They shall have the power to admit patients and to make regulations respecting them.

17. The President shall be a member *ex officio* of all committees, and the Vice-Presidents, Trustees, Treasurer, and Honorary Medical and Surgical Officers, shall be members *ex officio* of the Committee of Management.

18. The Committee of Management shall choose from among themselves a House Committee of seven, three to form a quorum, who shall attend to financial, medical, and domestic arrangements, and shall meet on such day and hour in each week as they may appoint, and have power to audit the house accounts, engage and discharge servants, and to regulate the internal management of the institution.

19. The House Committee shall at each of their meetings examine all recommendations for patients received since their last meeting, and shall have power to discharge any patient who in their opinion is not a fit and proper person to receive the benefits of the institution.

20. The Committee of Management shall present a general report of the affairs of the institution, at the annual meeting of Governors and Subscribers in January of each year.

21. No member of the Committee of Management or officer of the Hospital, shall be a contractor or become security for a contractor, directly or indirectly.

22. Any annually elected member of the Committee of Management neglecting his duty for three successive meetings without reasonable cause, shall after receiving notice in writing of such absence, cease to be a member.

23. All moneys received on account of the Hospital shall be paid to the Treasurer, and appropriated by him to the purposes of the institution, under the direction of the Committee of Management.

24. Previously to making any payment the Treasurer shall require a warrant from the Committee of Management authorising such payment, which shall be signed by the President, or a Vice-President, and a member of House Committee, and countersigned by the Secretary.

25. The officers of the institution shall consist of a Resident Surgeon, Collector, Dispenser, House Steward and Secretary, and Matron.

## HONORARY MEDICAL OFFICERS.

26. They shall consist of three legally qualified Medical and three legally qualified Surgical Officers, who shall be elected for one year.

27. One of the Honorary Medical and one of the Honorary Surgical Officers shall attend the Hospital each day, the rotation of duty to be regulated by *them*.

28. The Honorary Medical and Surgical Officers, shall have access to the institution at all times.

29. The Honorary Surgeons shall perform all capital surgical operations, but no capital operation shall be performed without a previous consultation of the surgical staff, except in cases of emergency; and the Honorary Medical and Surgical Officers respectively, shall regularly consult in all cases of importance, or protracted continuance in the house.

30. Any Honorary Medical or Surgical Officer neglecting his duty for one month without reasonable cause shall after receiving notice in writing, cease to be a member of the institution, and another officer shall be appointed in his stead.

31. The Honorary Medical Officers shall make a daily report, to be inserted in a book kept for that purpose.
