The President Reports

TO THE LIFE GOVERNORS
AND CONTRIBUTORS

Ladies and Gentlemen,

I present, on behalf of the Board of Management, the 104th Annual Report and audited Financial Statements for the year ended 30th June, 1963.

Each year the Committee has to face the problem of rising bed costs. However while this year the cost of running the Hospital increased from £67,804 to £69,031 an addition of only £1227 or just under 2%; the fact that more patients were treated resulted in the cost of maintaining each occupied bed per day remaining the same as last year at £6/14/1.

This year has been marked by the receipt of outstanding contributions and legacies, particularly from the Estate of the Late Miss Mary Urquhart. The Committee hopes to put these funds towards additional buildings and renovations to the Hospital to improve facilities for treatment as well as providing improved working conditions for the staff. Increased Maintenance Grants has helped to improve our financial position, and in this regard the assistance rendered by the Hospitals and Charities Commission has been most helpful.

Late in the year the Peter McCallum Cancer Clinic discontinued their clinic which operated from the Hospital with the result that Stawell patients are now obliged to attend the clinic at Ararat. The Committee has expressed its deep concern at the closing of the Stawell Clinic and has asked the Cancer Institute Board to receive a deputation to enable a case to be put forward for the re-establishment of the Stawell Clinic.

In every Hospital as in this one, there is a large amount of service rendered in an honorary capacity and to those who participate in this we tender our grateful thanks, not only from the Hospital, but on behalf of those to whom the services are rendered. These honorary services are given by the Medical, Legal, Dental and Religious professions.

To the Ladies Auxiliary, Hospital Ball Committee and other committees we give special thanks for the mighty work that has been done by them from year to year.



A cordial relationship has always prevailed between the Press and our Committee. The provision of copies of the Stawell Times-News by the proprietors is a gesture which is greatly appreciated.

To Matron and her Staff we tender our sincere thanks for their work and I would personally like to acknowledge the support given to me during my year in office by the Committee, Staff and the public and I trust this spirit of co-operation will continue in the future to enable the people of Stawell and District to enjoy a modern and efficient Hospital Service.
