You can recover a considerable portion, if not all, of your Hospital Account by becoming a member of a Registered Hospital Benefits Scheme and serving the necessary probationary periods. It is in your own interests to join one of the schemes available — the outlay is very small in comparison with the benefits available.

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## PENSIONERS

Pensioners are eligible to claim free treatment as a **public patient** on producing their pensioners' medical entitlement card to the admitting officer, and asking for public ward accommodation.
