The President's Report



To the Life Governors and
Contributors
Ladies and Gentlemen,

I have much pleasure in presenting to you the 115th Annual Report and Audited Financial Statements for the year ended 30th June, 1974.

At a time when we are experiencing an era of spiralling costs it is pleasing to be able to state that our average daily bed cost of \$26.72 was slightly lower than last year — (the average bed cost in 1972/73 for Victorian Public Hospitals was \$39.83). Our figure was held stable despite increases in the cost of most commodities and wages, by an increase in the number of patients treated of over 50%.

The Committee in co-operation with the Ararat and District Hospital has established both Pathology and Radiology Services on a part-time visiting basis. Both services are filling a need within the community and it is possible these will expand as the need grows.

Also during the year we were able to commence a Visiting Nursing Service and this also has been a much needed community service both for the older folk and for those who have been in Hospital but need follow up treatment at home. The service, since commencing late last year, has visited 36 different patients and carried out 1028 visits.

It may be of interest to the public that during the year there were 100 admissions the W. H. Syme Ward. A number of these included some short stay patients who were admitted on more than one occasion but I am sure you must feel proud, as we are, that our nineteen bed unit has been able to afford relief to so many Stawell and district people.

FINANCE

Our financial statement shows a deficit of \$7568 for the year. However, our main concern is that we have outstanding book debts now of \$83,974 compared with \$32,650 last year and a somewhat similar increase in our Maintenance Bank overdraft figure which is now \$77,113. The book debts are equivalent to approximately three months accounts and as the Hospital itself enjoys only 2 weeks credit to meet just on 80% of its current expenditure, and normal credit terms for the remainder, it is a serious situation.

Patients coming into the Hospital are asked to bring Hospital Benefit membership books, or Lodge claim forms with them, and sign authorisation forms at the Hospital Office for the Hospital to make claims for accounts. Those who prefer to lodge their own claims or who are not members of any Benefit organisation are asked to pay accounts on discharge. This co-operation by the public will help the Hospital considerably.

BUILDINGS AND EQUIPMENT

A sum of \$15,727 was expended on Building and Equipment. The major costs were the provision of Cardiac equipment, costing \$4500, payments totalling \$3700 to the Syme Ward contractor, \$1000 for additional Office equipment, \$1860 for Boiler modifications, Electrical extensions and new grounds lighting.
