The President's Report

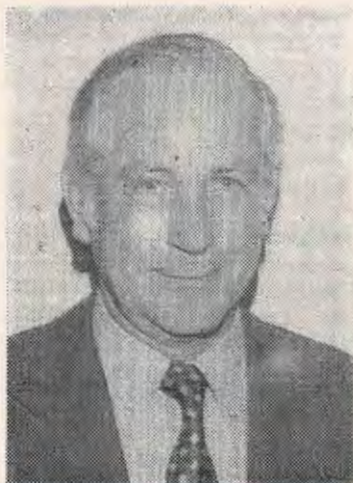

To the Life Governors and
Contributors.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

I have much pleasure in presenting to you the 119th Annual Report and Audited Financial Statements for the year ended 30th June, 1978.

Our Hospital has been very busy throughout the year and this has taxed the staff and facilities to their utmost. At times, it has been necessary to utilise all existing space, including the placing of extra beds in wards and corridors. The high standard of medical care we have come to expect has been maintained in spite of these difficulties. I do thank, on your behalf, the visiting Medical Staff, Matron and Nursing Staff for their continued dedication to the care of our patients. These staff again received the full support of our Office, Domestic and Maintenance Staff.



Our Administration/Ward Building Project and the Grounds project as outlined in the previous report have not been carried out — primarily because funds were not available from the Hospitals and Charities Commission by way of grants.

The Chairman of the Hospitals and Charities Commission Dr E. Wilder received a deputation from the Committee on 4th April when the following matters were raised:

1. Administration/Ward Building Project
2. Sisters Home Heating
3. Utilization of existing buildings for expanding services (including use of now unoccupied Nurses Quarters)
 - (a) Increased space for Pathology
 - (b) Re-location Central Sterile Supply
 - (c) Extension of Kitchen and food service area
 - (d) Pharmacy
 - (e) Storage space for equipment not in use
 - (f) Outpatients area
 - (g) Boiler House modifications or replacement
4. Survey of staffing needs of all sections of the Hospital
5. Driveway and parking area sealing.

Following this meeting four officers from the Commission, Dr R. Race, Miss J. Nixon, Mr S. Thornton and Mr A. Cowie visited the Hospital on 10th May for a close inspection and "on the spot" discussions with Committee Members and Hospital Staff. We are now awaiting recommendations from the Commission which should set the pattern for our planning over the next few years.

FINANCE

The net result from the years activities so far as the Operating Account was concerned showed a surplus of \$15,636. For several months, the financial position caused a good deal of concern as the level of ordinary government grants were below previous years amounts, however in the last two months of the year the position improved. We have also received \$47,100 from the Hospitals and Charities Commission in reduction of last year's deficit of \$68,659. This has again placed our Operating Account on a sound basis.

Despite increased use of the Hospital facilities — 303 more inpatients, 395 more operations, 4995 more outpatient treatments, coupled with the fact that the Hospital does not fix the price of goods it purchases, nor the wages it is required to pay staff, actual costs were kept close to those of the previous year. The average daily bed cost per patient rose by only \$2.93.

DISASTER PLANNING

A disaster planning Sub-Committee was appointed during the year under the chairmanship of Mr G. H. Wade until his resignation, then Mr M. M. Robson was charged with the responsibility of drawing up a disaster plan for the Hospital. We are very grateful to both of these men for their work on this project.

The Sub-Committee prepared a handbook for quick reference in the event of an emergency, based on a handbook in use at the Alfred Hospital, and has also prepared a more detailed manual. Some staff training has been carried out with the co-operation of the Country Fire Authority, State Emergency Service and the Stawell Urban Fire Brigade but with changing staff, training is a continuing process.

COMMITTEE OF MANAGEMENT

Cr E. C. Lewis (Municipal Nominee) relinquished his position on the Committee on 11-5-78 after serving for a period of 3½ years. Mr G. H. Wade resigned on 13-6-78 when he left Stawell to take up a position in Melbourne. Mr Wade had joined the Committee only a year earlier. Mr T. W. Sainsbury was granted leave of absence for the time he is overseas and leave for varying periods was granted to Messrs L. R. Erwin, J. K. McCracken and Mr M. M. Robson.
