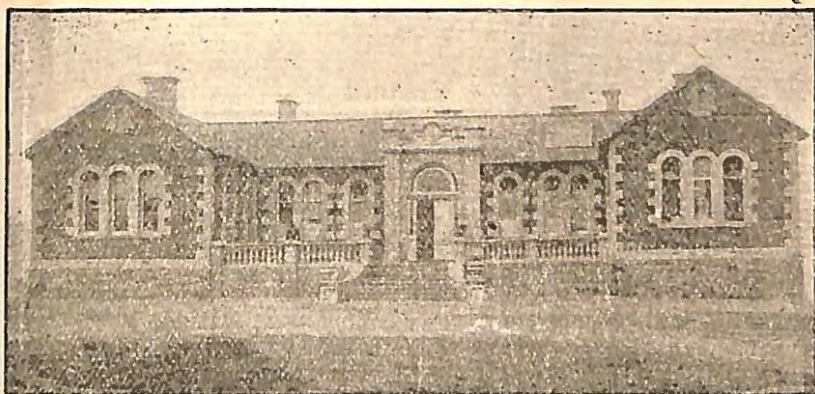

TO THE SUBSCRIBERS. —

The Committee of Management of the Stawell and District Hospital have the honour to submit to the Subscribers their 62nd Annual Report and Balance Sheet for the Financial Year ended 30th June, 1921.

FINANCIAL. —

The income from all sources for the year just ended amounts to £2258 18s 5d (being an increase of over £200 on last year's figures) and the expenditure to £2466 13s 2d (a decrease of £250).

The Committee greatly appreciate the liberal support given by the public as evidenced by the fact that the amount of local contributions has again increased this year by about £170. The following donations have been received during the year:— Estate Sir W. A. Zeal, £5; Estate Patrick Brennan, £40; Edward Wilson Charitable Fund, £40; Alfred Felton Bequest, £30; George Rolfe's Trustees, £20; John Kennedy's Estate, £50; Walter and Eliza Hall, £10; Stawell Brass Band, £279 13s 5d; Landsborough and Marnoo Bands, £170 7s 2d; Estate Joseph Kronheimer, £5; Stawell Croquet Club, £7 7s; Scotch College Dramatic Coy., £10 19s 2d; Proceeds of Hospital Ball, 1920 (per Mrs J. A. Larkan), £48 12s 6d; Hospital Ball Committee, 1921 (per the Mayor), £38 18s 6d; Button Day Girls per Miss Fawcett, £13 19s.

STAFF. —

Dr N. M'Coll resigned his position as Resident Surgeon in January. We appointed Dr W. L. Aitken to the position. He commenced duty on February 1st, 1921. The Committee tender their thanks to the Matron and Nursing Staff for the attention paid by them to all cases in the Institution. Sister M. E. Williams resigned her position at the hospital for a similar position at the Geelong Hospital, and the Committee have appointed Miss Ruby Thompson of Deniliquin, to fill the vacancy. She is to commence duty on August 1st.

We are pleased to report that Nurse Teresa Healy and Nurse Annie Gullan passed their R.V.T.N.A. Examination during this year.

Special thanks are due to Mr R. Code and his willing fellow workers, who by their zeal and energy did so much towards making the recent Wood Bee a great success. Some 200 tons of firewood resulted from the combined efforts of volunteer axemen, carters, and workers of various kinds who gave their labour for the hospital. So liberal too, were the monetary and other donations that the Institution has received a great benefit at a small cost to its funds.
