## Fifty-fifth Annual Report.

---

*To the Governors and Subscribers  
of the Ballarat District Hospital.*

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN —

Your Committee has again the honor of presenting to you the Annual Report and Balance Sheet for the past year ending on the 30th June, and has once more to thank the subscribers for their continued support of such a useful Institution. In the various tables which follow will be found the financial position, details of the cases treated, and the attention given by the Staff and Committee to the management of the Hospital.

There have been 1288 In-patients and 1388 Out-patients treated (the total visits of the latter being 5221) during the term, while the casualties numbered 505.

The daily average for the year has been 101 at a cost per head of £52 8s. 7d. per annum, which is below the mean of Victorian Hospitals.

The gross income for the year was £7467 12s, but this includes £2249 2s. 4d. drawn from the Testamentary Account on the advice of the State Treasurer, and there is undoubted evidence that the ordinary income of the Hospital must be increased from some source to enable it to carry on its work without depleting its funds.

The Charities Bill is again to be brought before Parliament and should it become law we look for better treatment in regard to the Government grant which has been much reduced in the last ten years, although expenses in all directions have been greater.

The systems of Hot Water Radiation for the Queen Victoria Women's Ward and the Steam Kettles for sterilizing and other purposes in all the wards have been completed and are giving satisfaction and show a saving in fuel and gas, in addition to being much more cleanly.



## RESIDENT SURGEON'S REPORT.

GENTLEMEN—

I have the honor to report that during the year ended June 30th, 1912, 1288 In-patients were treated; of these 131 died, a percentage death rate of 10·17.

The following cases of Infectious Diseases were treated:—  
Typhoid Fever, 59 cases, with 4 deaths; Diphtheria, 137 cases, with 7 deaths; Scarlet Fever, 39 cases, with no death; and Erysipelas, 8 cases, with 3 deaths.

## BYE-LAWS OF THE BALLARAT DISTRICT HOSPITAL

Incorporated under 27 Vic No 220.

1. The object of the Institution is to afford Medical and Surgical Aid to poor persons requiring it, irrespective of country or creed, and for casualties; but no person who shall meet with casualties, and be found able to pay for aid elsewhere, shall receive further than temporary assistance.

2. The Institution shall consist of a President, two Vice-Presidents, Treasurer, Governors, and Contributors.

3. The following shall be the qualifications and privileges of Governors and Contributors.

£30 Personal Contribution (in one year)	- -	Life Governor.
£15 " " "	- -	Life Subscriber.
£50 Donation by society, association, or company	} *to nominate	Life Governor.
£25 Donation by society, association, or company		
£50 First-named executor (bequest under will)	-	Governor for one year.

£20 Layman	-	do.
£20 Society, association, or company collecting	} *to nominate	do.

£2 2s. Yearly Subscription (entitling to sit on Committee)	-	Contributor.

With the privilege of voting at all general and special meetings of Governors and Contributors, and with power to recommend patients, according to the undermentioned scale:—

Life Governor—2 in-patients or 6 out-patients always on the books.

Life Subscriber—1 in-patient or 3 out-patients always on the books.

Governor for one year—10 in-patients and 20 out-patients annually.

Governor—4 in-patients and 8 out-patients annually.

Contributor—2 in-patients and 4 out-patients annually.

\*N B.—Nominations of Governors and Contributors must be made prior to 30th June of each year, and be subject to the approval of the Committee of Management. Firms subscribing may nominate one of their members as a Governor or Contributor who shall be entitled to vote and hold office.

4. Annual Subscriptions must be paid in advance for the current year, such year to be computed from the day on which such subscription is paid, and no Governor or Contributor will be entitled to any privilege until the subscription be paid.

5. Life, Honorary, and Annual Governors, Life and Annual Subscribers, all Honorary Officers and other Contributors of £1 and upwards per annum, shall be entitled to one vote at all meetings of Governors and Contributors to the Hospital.

6. No person shall vote as a Governor or Contributor while he is a salaried officer or pupil of the Hospital; nor any Governor or Contributor unless his subscription shall have been paid one month previously.
